## 2024 47<sup>th</sup> Worthen Memorial Contest Rules and Entry Form DEADLINE FOR ENTRY FORMS AND FEES IS 8:30 A.M. SATURDAY or SUNDAY, the day your division competes FIDDLERS & JUDGES MEETING @ 8:40 AM SATURDAY & SUNDAY

- 1. Entry fees and applications are due the day of your division competition, by 8:30am. The order of division competitions is listed on the Registration Form.
- 2. Contestants shall draw numbers for initial order of appearance in each division entered. Order of play will then be posted after registration is complete. Contestants who are not ready when called to play may be disqualified.
- 3. Contestants are **strongly encouraged** to attend the fiddler and judges' meetings. Any rule changes, clarifications and/or answers to questions will be provided at that time. Failure to attend will NOT be reason for not knowing about any such changes presented there.
- 4. All fiddler age divisions except Small Fry, Jr. Jr. and Novice: each contestant shall play two rounds consisting of a hoedown, waltz and tune of their choice (not a waltz or hoedown).
- 5. **Small Fry, Junior/Junior** and **Novice** divisions will play **one round** consisting of a hoedown, waltz and tune of their choice (not a waltz or hoedown).
- 6. **Novice** division accepts <u>beginning</u> level fiddlers of any age, who have not competed in a contest previously. Participation in the Novice division is <u>in lieu of entering an age group category</u>.
- 7. **Accompanists** will play **one round** of two (2) tunes, a fast and a slow in any order. There will be a four (4) minute time limit.
- 8. **Other stringed instruments** (Viola, Cello, Banjo, Mandolin, Guitar (picking), Dulcimers, etc.) will play **one round** of two (2) tunes a hoedown and a waltz. There will be a (4) minute time limit.
- 9. **Vocal division** will perform **one round** of one (1) tune. Tunes are accepted from the country, bluegrass, old time, swing, Appalachian or Celtic styles. There will be a three (3) minute time limit. Performer may have up to 3 accompanists. Vocal division will have separate judges.
- 10. **Twin Fiddle** will play **two rounds** of two (2) tunes, a fast and a slow in any order. There will be a four (4) minute time limit.
- 11. **Trick and/or Fancy** fiddling (hokum bowing, plucking, etc) is permitted only in the **Trick and Fancy** division, and not in the age divisions or championship division. There will be **two rounds** with one tune played in each round. There will be a four (4) minute time limit.
- 12. No tune may be played more than once by the same contestant during all divisions of the fiddle contest or band competition, if applicable. Repeating tunes may result in disqualification.
- 13. There is a **five (5) minute time limit** across all fiddler age divisions. Other divisions as listed. 10 points will be deducted from the total score for each 30-second interval over, or portion thereof. (If the time limit is 5 minutes, a 10-point deduction is assessed at 5 minutes 1 second and another 10 points will be deducted at 5 minutes 31 seconds and so on at each subsequent 30-second interval thereafter.)
- 14. NO MEDLEYS may be played in any category.

- 15. Each contestant may have no more than <u>three</u> accompanists, no amplified or electrical instruments allowed. Accompanists must have an instrument type OTHER than the category (i.e. a fiddle cannot have another fiddle accompany them in a fiddle division).
- 16. There will be three judges. Decisions of the judges will be final.
- 17. Contestants will be judged on tone, rhythm, intonation, technique and old time style. Score sheets will be available upon completion of the contest. Competitors may not use sheet music on stage.
- 18. Scores will be posted after each round of play. Grand Champion scores will not be posted.
- 19. Division tiebreakers will be played at the end of each division with one hoedown being played.
- 20. The **Grand Champion** division will be **one round** held on Sunday after all other divisions have played. The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners of <u>each age division of fiddlers</u> are automatically entered into this category and there is no entry fee. Winners are welcome (and encouraged) to attend on Sunday afternoon to play in this division.
- 21. **Grand Champion** division contestants will play two tunes one fast and one slow in any order with a four (4) minute limit. Numbers will be drawn right before the division play begins.
- 22. If a string breaks, the fiddler may continue or stop. If the tune is complete, it will be judged as played. If the fiddler stops, he/she will be allowed to begin with that tune and complete his/her program. The time limit will be appropriately adjusted to the start of that time.
- 23. Any performer winning first place in *any* division three years in succession must lay out for one year before competing again in the division in which they won first place though they may compete in other categories for which they would otherwise be eligible.
- 24. Disputes will be submitted to the judges and contest committee at the time of the event and a decision rendered at that time. The decision of the judges and committee on the problem presented will be final.
- 25. Any person hired by the contest (i.e. judges and hired accompanists) may not compete in the contest.
- 26. Any questions on rules may be submitted before or during the Judges meeting and will be considered by the judges and/or committee as deemed appropriate by the committee. Answers and clarifications will be provided at the judges meeting on the Saturday and Sunday of the event.
- 27. Recordings may be sold. AOTFA will handle sales. Details and check in at the event.
- 28. Everyone have a GOOD TIME!

## **RULES FOR JUDGES:**

\*Scoring will range from 80 to 100, with 90 being average. Please initial your score sheets. \*Score on tone, rhythm, intonation, technique and old time style

\*Mark off points if contestant loses tune, stops or starts over, or plays wrong type of tune.

\*No talking or discussion of contestants while contest is in progress.

\*Do NOT total any scores or mark off for over time. Tabulation and overtime deductions done by office.
