JACK DARLAND

Jack Darland was born into a musical family on March 21, 1926, with both grandfathers playing the fiddle and his mother and grandmother playing the piano. His father also picked the mandolin a bit.

His musical career began when he was presented with a 12 base Horner accordion at the young age of eight. He learned many of the old tunes and played at the old country school-house dances with his grandfathers.

His Grandpa Sprouls passed away while Jack was serving in the Navy during World War II, and it was his wish that Jack have his fiddle. That began a long career of fiddling that continued throughout his life.

Jack spent many years playing for dances in the Council-Weiser area of Idaho. He met his future wife, Linda in 1971, they became a duo and moved to Baker, Oregon in 1972. They played their first of many contests in August of 1972.

Jack and Linda moved to Salome, Arizona in September of 1988. Their first contest in Arizona was Globe, in 1991. There have been numerous contests and campouts since, where they cherished the musical "family" they had became a part of.

Jack has won the Arizona State Senior Contest in Payson, three times, as well as many other contests through the years. He is perhaps best known for his unwavering "old time" fiddling style that he refused to abandon. Jack judged many contests over the years and became known as a fair and unbiased judge, although strictly "old time".

He and Linda made a number of tapes and CD's, and their music has gone all across the United States and Canada. When you attend any fiddle function, you are sure to hear a tune that the fiddler will say, "I learned that from Jack Darland".

Jack passed away at his home on June 3, 2022, leaving his wife of 50 years, Linda,, one

son Jim, from Mt. Vernon, Washington, four grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his son Clark.

He passed away on June 12, 2022 at 12:45 a.m.




